Each floorcovering firm contracted to perform work at *Summa Health System's hospitals* will bear responsibility in verifying its employees performing the work, regardless of the tier of subcontracting, **must have the aforesaid approved training**. This includes all necessary preparatory work. At this time *Summa Health System* recognizes INSTALL as the only acceptable training and certification.

It is the intent that these requirements will take effect on August 1, 2015 and will be a pre-requisite per the bid specifications for all projects to be performed at *Summa Health System's hospitals*.
